Things to know before you go

Registration

As a keynote or invited speaker, you should be registered to attend the conference with a waived fee code. If you have not done so until 1 September, your registration has been done automatically. Please contact event@graphene-flagship.eu if you cannot attend the event.


Presentation Format

- Keynote lecture with 45 minutes, 10 minutes of Q&A to follow.
- Invited talk with 30 minutes, 5 minutes of Q&A to follow.
- Please introduce yourself to the Session Chair no later than 15 minutes before your presentation
- Please use 16:9 format for your slides. <u>Logos here</u>. Find <u>template here.</u>
- Make sure that all graphics, fonts and videos (including audio) are saved within the PPT presentation.
- Save your presentation file as: **Presentation date (xx.xx.xxxx) RoomName (**<u>see online programme</u>) **FirstLastName.** Avoid queuing.
- <u>Upload your presentation here</u> or bring your presentation on a USB-stick to the Media Desk.
- Note: speakers presenting on stage at the Auditorium need to exit the Auditorium at the east Exit, go left and follow the yellow signs.

Media Desk & Technical Equipment

- The Media Desk is located on the ground floor of the venue assisting presenters between 8:00 and 18:00.
- Visit the Media Desk at least one hour before your talk to ensure your presentation was uploaded and check compatibility with LCD projectors.
- LCD projector, screen, PC, podium microphone or lapel microphone and laser pointer will be provided in the meeting room.








Conference Location

The conference will provide you with:


- Your identification Badge. It must be worn and visible at all times, to gain access to the BMW Welt, the lunchroom, the welcome reception and conference dinner.
